

Kingston Parish Council 11 May 2022 Appendix 5 - Item 14

Kingston Parish Hall Replacement Windows

1. KPC has agreed to fund replacement windows for the Parish Hall from the Saxondown easement fund. Kingston Parish Hall are now seeking agreement from KPC for the money to be released. Details of our proposal are set out below.

2. Our plans are to replace:

- the three Crittal style windows in the main hall along the north west side of the building with white aluminium frame windows double glazed with clear glass
- the two Crittal style windows on the front of the building with white aluminium frame windows double glazed with opaque glass
- the soft wood single glazed fire doors and side panel on the south west side of the building with white PVC fire doors and panel double glazed with safety glass.

We have opted for aluminium frames to replace the crittal style windows as they are high quality and long lasting and similar in design to the original windows but PVC for the fire doors and panel so as to be in keeping with the existing PVC windows and doors along the south west side and at the back of the building which do not need replacing.

3. We have requested pre-application planning advice from SDNPA and are waiting to here (Note due 28 April).

4. We have obtained two quotes both from local suppliers which are attached. We wish to accept the quote from Lewes glass who were able to provide more detailed information about the products, supply and timing of installation.

5. We are therefore seeking approval of funding, pending the response from the planning department about planning permission, for the following:

3 standard aluminium windows in the main hall	£4,317
2 standard aluminium windows to the front	£1,896
PVC Fire escape doors and panel	£2,536
Redecoration	£300
TOTAL.	£9,049
