Notice board at the Community Garden to be installed 17<sup>th</sup> Feb. Notices will give monthly updates of things to see in the garden. Also, a programme of events.

Quote for shelter at Community garden is £4 400. A check is to be made as to whether Planning permission is required.

The Community Garden is to invite new councillors and Chair to the garden.

Castelmer was discussed. Concerns about sewage and surface drainage were raised. The question was asked about the truncated footpath, LEW / 37 / 1 (above Springbarn Farm) and if it's reinstatement / creation would be part of the planning process.

The Action Group would like to congratulate KPC for decision to go ahead with finger-post replacement.

Can an item be written in The Kingston News about progress on Phase 2 of the traffic calming.

Did KPC agree to maintain the infrastructure for some of the phase 1 elements. Notably, wooden posts have rotted and fall over.

When will the Parish section of Church Lane be repaired as per the condition for granting access over it?

Concerns over condition of Breach Road Track as it floods and is impossible in winter. DH pointed out that the section in question is in Iford Parish. Could we ask Iford Estates when we ask about FP KIN / 2/1 (Wellgreen Lane to Swanborough)
