

New Exercise Equipment for St Pancras Green

With input from the whole community, Kingston Parish Council is providing some new exercise equipment on St Pancras Green. A community-wide consultation on how to spend the easement money from the Saxondown development money resulted in a list of suggested projects and information was circulated in council reports and discussed at council meetings, allowing everyone to contribute.

Many people who responded to the consultation asked for more activities to take place on the sports field at St Pancras Green and the new equipment was chosen to appeal to all members of the community from the youngest to the oldest – the items being installed are some outdoor gym equipment, a Boule court and goals for netball and basketball.

The installation starts on 11th September and will take about 3 weeks.

Care has been taken to choose locations that minimise disturbance, whilst ensuring good accessibility.

The gym equipment (A) will be going between the pavilion and the top tennis court.

The Boule court (B) will sit beside the top tennis court, with care taken to maintain access for dog walkers to be able to give the dogs a good run from the seats used every day. Once the installation is complete, one of the benches might need to be moved, but that can be arranged if needed.



The basketball and netball goals (C) will be tucked behind the bottom tennis court.
