231115 Item 12 Update from the Transport Steering Group (TSG)

Tenders for consultancy services were submitted from the four invited consultants by the closing date of 5pm Friday 20th October. The tenders were assessed by the TSG in accordance with the tender invitation and were discussed at a meeting on the 30th October. Both Ethos – 2020 and Transport Initiatives submitted very strong tenders but on balance it was recommended that the contract should be awarded to Ethos for the reasons given in the following table.
